



Phase 1 Test Plan

Validate Brochureware/Notifications

- 1) In the top header back select the “Tell a Friend” link. Enter a 2nd email address (or your own address). Within 30 minutes the email you entered will get an email describing equipment barn with your name in the subject and the body.
- 2) Make sure all the main buttons in the header work. (Equipment, Auctions, FAQ, etc.)
- 3) Click on the site map link in the header and verify that the links in the site map work.
- 4) Select the “Ask a Question” and/or “Make a Suggestion” links from the footer at the bottom of the page-Leave a note if you want a response and I will validate that I got it-if you don’t get a response then there is probably a bug there.
- 5) Select the “About Us” page in the footer and click on the small EquipmentBarn logo in the lower right corner-it should take you to the EquipmentBarn page within Paul-Julia.com. Check out Paul-Julia.com or select back to return to testing.

Validate Login/User Creation

- 1) Go to the Sign In Page
- 2) Create a new user by selecting the join link
- 3) Create a user and be sure an enter a valid email address
- 4) After the creation of the user you should be taken to the homepage and within 30 minutes a welcome email will be sent. Continue with test but validate email is correct when it arrives.
- 5) Sign out of the system and return to the sign in page, select the link that says “Lost Password”, enter your email address and submit.
- 6) You should immediately get an email containing the password you created in step 2.
- 7) Log back in and select the “My Profile” link in the header and verify that all information is still correct.
- 8) Go back to “Tell a Friend” and verify that your name is now defaulted in to the from box.

If you have more than 1 email address and you have time go ahead and create another user and select auctioneer and/or dealer in the user creation for a different welcome email and set of informational screens.

Creating/Viewing Auctions

- 1) Go to the auctions tab and view the auctions, try various combinations of viewing by state and auction type.
- 2) Create a new auction by selecting the “Post an Auction” link in the header and create an auction, the date should be EXACTLY 2 days from today. Create a 2nd auction exactly 14 days from today. (If there are a lot of auctions you may want to select some obscure state to make your auctions easier to find).
- 3) Follow the “My Auction Alerts” link in the header and create a reminder for the state and auction type of your auctions. Within an hour you should receive ONE email with links to each of the TWO auctions. Follow the links in the email to make sure they return the detail page of the auctions you posted.
- 4) Next return to the auctions listing page and select the “Remind Me” link next to each of the auction in the grid. Within an hour you should receive TWO emails containing the reminders for ONE auctions including links to the detail pages. When you receive the email follow the links to validate they are pointing to the correct auctions.
- 5) Follow the link to “My Posted Auctions” and delete or update one or both of the auctions. Return to the Auction List and verify the changes have been made.

Paul Regression Tests-Run through these at least once before each release (31 steps).

Login/Welcome Emails

- 1) Create a new farm only user and login
- 2) Return to Sign In Page and select lost password
- 3) Validate Welcome Email (farmer only email) and lost password email
- 4) Logout & Restart Browser
- 5) Make some changes to profile
- 6) Restart Browser Log Back in and Verify Changes were made

- 7) Create a new auctioneer user (or auctioneer and dealer) and login
- 8) Validate Welcome Email (should be different from other)
- 9) Go back & make some profile changes to auction co section-Select to “remember me”
- 10) Logout and back in and validate auction-co changes were made

Creating Auctions

- 11) Go to auctions page (still as auctioneer id) and create an auction-auction should be > 3 days away but less than 2 weeks.
- 12) Create another auction that is 2 days away-it should be in the same state as #6 and of same type (land, estate, etc.)
- 13) Validate that they show up in the list of active auctions
- 14) Tell A Friend About an auction
- 15) View a detail page
- 16) Check one with a link to an external site
- 17) Test the link to validate it shows up in a new window

Viewing Auctions

- 18) Go back in as the auctioneer and view the auctions, sort by various combinations of states and types.
- 19) Select the “My Posted Auctions” and see the two created earlier
- 20) Edit one and then go back and view the detail on the other page & validate changes
- 21) Go back to My Posted Auctions and view the detail there
- 22) Delete one of the auctions and then go back and make sure it doesn’t show up on the main screen

Getting auction reminders and alerts

- 23) Log back in as the farm user created in step 1 and on the auctions page and select to be alerted to be alerted for auctions in the state and of the auctions created in step 6 & 7.
- 24) Drop out and run the eb_aucalert.pl. Should get an email that contains alerts about TWO auctions.
- 25) Follow the links in the emails to the auctions and validate that they are correct.
- 26) Go and select “remind me” about the 2 auctions
- 27) Drop out and run the eb_aucemin.pl script and should get 2 emails with reminders about the auction
- 28) Go back into the auction alerts screen and delete the alerts
- 29) Restart browser and verify the alerts are gone
- 30) Log back in as the auctioneer who created the auction and change the one 14 days out to be 2 days out.
- 31) Drop out and rerun the eb_aucemin.pl again...should get no notifications for the farmer user.
